After due consideration, the Court **grants** appellees, Woodrow V. Lesikar Family Trust by and through its beneficiary, Carolyn Ann Lesikar Moon Special Trust, and its Trustee, Woody K. Lesikar Special Trust, and Carolyn Ann Lesikar Moon's motion to dismiss the appeal for lack of jurisdiction. Accordingly, the Court **dismisses** the appeal for lack of jurisdiction.

The Court **orders** that the appellant, Woody K. Lesikar, individually, and as Trustee of the Woody K. Lesikar Special Trust, pay all appellate costs.

The Court **orders** that this decision be certified below for observance.
