ORDER

On July 9, 2019, appellants filed a notice of appeal from an order signed June 26, 2019, and the appeal was assigned to this court under our appellate number 14-19-00547-CV. On July 19, 2019, appellants filed a notice of appeal from a judgment signed June 19, 2019, which was assigned to this court under our appellate number 14-19-00571-CV. On April 27, 2020, appellants filed a motion to stay the appeal in 14-19-00547-CV or, in the alternative, consolidate these related appeals. On May 6, 2020, appellees David Hill d/b/a DOH Oil Co., Cassie Mosely and David Mosely responded. They are opposed to a stay of the appeal in 14-19-00547-CV but do not oppose consolidation of the appeals.

We deny appellants' motion to stay. We grant appellants' motion in the alternative to consolidate the related appeals. Accordingly, we order the appeals pending under our appellate case numbers 14-19-00547-CV and 14-19-00571-CV **CONSOLIDATED.**
