ORDER GRANTING THOMAS HARRINGTON, PAUL HARRINGTON, AND HARRINGTON FAMILY TRUST'S MOTION TO DECLARE CHRISTINE E. REULE A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT

After considering Defendant Thomas Harrington, Paul Harrington, and Harrington Family Trust's Motion to Declare Christine E. Reule to be a Vexatious Litigant, Plaintiff Christine E. Reule's response thereto, the argument of counsel, the pleadings, and the evidence on file, the Court is of the opinion that the Motion should be GRANTED in its entirety.

IT IS THERFORE ORDERED that said Motion is GRANTED in its entirety and that:

- Plaintiff Christine E. Reule ("Plaintiff") is declared by this Court to be a 'vexatious litigant under Tex. Civ. PRAC. & REM. CODE §§ 11.051-11.054;
- 2. Plaintiff shall furnish \$7,500.00 in security to the Court within 40 days of this Order;
- 3. This matter is stayed until such security is furnished to the Court, except that Plaintiff's claims shall be dismissed if such security is not furnished within the required time period;
- Plaintiff is prohibited from filing any additional cases in this state and Smith
 County until such time that she pays all outstanding security, court costs,
 including costs for previous filings still outstanding;

- Plaintiff is prohibited from maintaining the current case until such time that she pays all outstanding security, court costs, including costs for previous filings still outstanding;
- 6. Plaintiff is required to obtain permission from the local administrative judges of a court in which she intends to file new litigation in this state and Smith County prior to filing any new litigation; and
- Notice of the prohibition to Plaintiff filing additional litigation shall be circulated with the Office of Court Administration and Clerk's Offices in and for Smith County, Texas.
