On October 7, 2019, the Court advised appellants that the reporter's record was overdue and that the court reporter had filed a notice that the reporter's record was not filed because appellant either had not requested it or had not paid for it or made arrangements to pay for it. Appellant was advised that unless the court received written proof by November 6, 2019 that arrangements had been made to pay for the reporter's record, he might be required to file a brief without a reporter's record. We received no response. The clerk's record was filed February 7, 2020. On April 9, 2020, the Court granted appellants' motion for extension of time to file the notice of appeal. The reporter's record has still not been filed.

Accordingly, the court will consider and decide those issues or points that do not require a reporter's record for a decision. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 37.3(c) (stating that, if clerk's record has been filed, appellate court may consider and decide those issues or points that do not require a reporter's record).

Appellant's brief must be filed no later than 30 days after the date of this order.

Appellees' brief will be due within 30 days after appellants' brief has been filed.
