Appellant, incarcerated and acting pro se, has filed a motion requesting access to a copy of the complete appellate record from cause numbers 2018-84841 and 2017-83864 for use in preparing his appeal, asserting he has received "an incomplete and inaccurate copy of the trial court record in this case on appeal." We **grant** the motion in part.

Specifically, appellant requests the clerk's record be supplemented to include "his bench warrant motions" that are "reflected in the records online at the District Clerk's website" and any other documents appellant filed that were not included in the original or supplemental clerk's record from cause number 2018-84841. We **order** the trial court clerk, no later than 10 days from the date of this order, to file in this Court and to provide to appellant a supplemental clerk's record, free of cost, containing the missing documents from cause number 2018-84841. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 20.1(c), 35.3(a), (c). The supplemental record is to be forwarded to appellant at the address in his motion:

Bradley Barton TDCJ ID# 1680744 Ferguson Unit 12120 Savage Drive Midway, Texas 75852

The trial court clerk shall certify to this Court, within 15 days of the date of this order, the date upon which delivery of the record is made to the appellant.

The Court further **grants** the motion to the extent any portion of the reporter's record has yet to be filed from cause number 2018-84841. On September 12, 2019, the court reporter indicated in a filing to this Court that there was a reporter's record. In addition, the "Contested Default Order Establishing the Parent-Child Relationship" in the Clerk's Record in cause number 2018-84841 states that a record of a July 24, 2019 hearing "was made by audio recording." We **order** the court reporter to file with this Court, within 30 days of the date of this order and at no cost to appellant, a reporter's record of any recorded proceedings in cause number 2018-84841, and to provide the reporter's record to the appellant at the address above, free of cost. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 20.1(c), 35.3(b), (c).

This Court **denies** appellant's request to order the trial court to provide copies of the clerk's record or reporter's record from cause number 2017-83864.

It is so ORDERED.
