MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant, Aime Diaw, has neither established indigence nor paid, or made arrangements to pay, the fee for preparing the clerk's record. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 37.3(b). After being notified on February 25, 2020 that this appeal was subject to dismissal, appellant did not respond. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 37.3(b), 42.3(b). Appellee

subsequently filed a motion to dismiss the appeal on May 15, 2020. More than ten days have elapsed since the filing of the motion and appellant has not responded. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 10.3(a). Accordingly, we grant the motion and dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution. We dismiss any other pending motions as moot.
