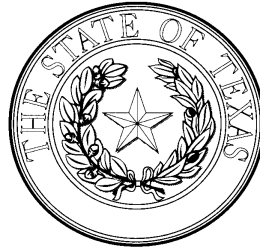

MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellants, Tamika Chelsea Harris, as HOA Board Member, Eliza Molina, as HOA Board Member, and Mittie Wilson, as HOA Board Member, have neither

established indigence for purposes of appellate costs nor paid or made arrangements to pay the fee for preparing the clerk's record. *See* TEX. R. CIV. P. 145; TEX. R. APP. P. 20.1, 37.3(a). After being notified that this appeal was subject to dismissal, appellants have not responded to this Court's notice and a clerk's record has not been filed. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 37.3(b), 42.3(b), (c).

Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 37.3(b), 42.3(b), (c), 43.2(f). We dismiss any pending motions as moot.
