MEMORANDUM OPINION

This is an appeal from a decree signed January 22, 2020. The notice of appeal was filed March 23, 2020. To date, our records show that appellant has not paid the appellate filing fee. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 5 (requiring payment of fees in civil cases unless party is excused by statute or by appellate rules from paying costs). Tex. Gov't Code Ann. § 51.207 (appellate fees and costs).

On April 23, 2020, this court ordered appellant to pay the appellate filing fee on or before May 5, 2020 or the appeal would be dismissed. Appellant has not paid the appellate filing fee or otherwise responded to the court's order. Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal. *See* Tex. R.
