ORDER

On May 7, 2020, this court issued an order directing appellant, Leslie Taylor, to notify the court that she was seeking counsel, file a motion to extend time to file a brief, or file a brief, within 30 days from the date of the order, and that failure to comply would result in her dismissal from this appeal.
