
ORDERED that:

 - d. submit a copy of the Order for publication in the *Texas Register*.



Rules Governing the Operation of the Texas Access to Justice Foundation

26. Confidentiality.

The files, records, proceedings, as they relate to the compliance or noncompliance of any attorney with the requirements of these Rules, shall be confidential and shall not be disclosed except upon consent of the attorney affected, ~~or~~ as directed in the course of judicial proceeding by a court of competent jurisdiction, or to the State Bar's Office of Chief Disciplinary Counsel.
