ORDER

On the 28th day of March, 2024 came on to be heard Bexar County Hospital District D/B/A University Health's ("University Health") Motion to Declare Plaintiff, Reginald Wilder II a Vexatious Litigant and Requiring Security for Costs, and Motion for a Prefiling Order. Reginald Wilder II appeared in person and announced ready OR did not appear, despite having received notice and agreeing to this setting.. Defendant, University Health appeared by and through its attorney of record, Erin R. McNiece and announced ready. Defendant, Texas Workforce Commission ("TWC") did not appear.

The Court, after hearing the evidence and argument of counsel, finds that a) there is no reasonable probability that Reginald Wilder II will prevail in this lawsuit against Defendants University Health and the TWC; and b) that Reginald Wilder II has, after his deadline to appeal the dismissal of his causes of action, repeatedly relitigated or attempted to relitigate, pro se, the validity of the determination against him, and in favor of University Health and TWC.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Reginald Wilder II is hereby declared to be a vexatious litigant.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADTIJDGED AND DECREED, that Reginald Wilder

II shall furnish security for University Health's reasonable expenses, including costs and attorney's fees to be incurred in defense of any further efforts by Reginald Wilder II to relitigate the final judgment in this cause, or to relitigate in any other forum the denial of unemployment benefits arising out of the termination of his employment with University Health, in the amount of \$ 5000.00 which security shall be by surety bond filed with the Bexar County District Clerk, or cash deposited with the registry of the Bexar County District Clerk, to be tendered to the Bexar County District Clerk on or before April 15, 2024.

FINALLY, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Reginald Wilder II be and hereby is prohibited from filing, in propria persona, any new litigation in any court in this State of Texas, without first securing the permission of the local administrative judge of the court in which he intends to file same.

All other relief requested, be and hereby is DENIED.

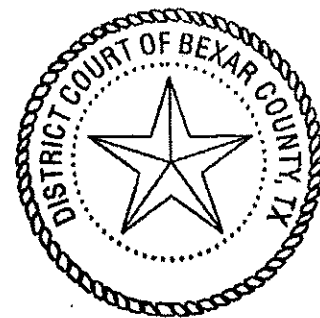
