- 1.) Parties must pay or make arrangements to pay for the reporter's record unless indigent.
- 2.) If a designation is not filed, the reporter is required to prepare a record according to TRAP 34.6(a) as well as the *Uniform Format Manual for Texas Reporters' Records*.
- 3.) In a criminal case in which a party requests a reporter's record, the court reporter must prepare a duplicate of the reporter's record and file it with the trial court clerk. TRAP 34.6(h)
- 4.) In addition to the paper copy, the Court requests an electronic copy of the reporter's record on a CD with a**searchable PDF format** until you are able to electronically file them online through the portal for TAMES.
- 5.) If you need additional time to prepare your record you will need to send in a request for extenion of time. A form is available on our web page.*

 A copy of your monthly report pursuant to TRAP 13.4 must accompany your request for extension of time.
