



### Detailed Description of Offenses in each Misdemeanor Category

- A Appeal of a Parking or Pedestrian Offense committed in a School Zone<sup>1</sup>
- B Appeal of a Parking or Pedestrian Offense committed outside a School Zone<sup>1</sup>
- C Appeal of conviction for Failure to Secure Child in Safety Seat System<sup>2</sup> that is committed in a school crossing zone<sup>1</sup>
- D Appeal of conviction for Failure to Secure Child in Safety Seat System<sup>2</sup> that is not committed in a school crossing zone<sup>1</sup>
- E Appeal of a Class C Misdemeanor Rules-of-the-Road Offense<sup>3</sup> other than a Parking or Pedestrian Offense or the offense of Failure to Secure Child in Safety Seat System<sup>2</sup> that:  
(1) is committed in a school crossing zone<sup>1</sup>; **and** (2) is a moving violation<sup>4</sup>
- F Appeal of a Class C Misdemeanor Rules-of-the-Road Offense<sup>3</sup> other than a Parking or Pedestrian Offense or the offense of Failure to Secure Child in Safety Seat System<sup>2</sup> that:  
(1) is committed in a school crossing zone<sup>1</sup>; **and** (2) is not a moving violation<sup>4</sup>
- G Appeal of a Class C Misdemeanor Rules-of-the-Road Offense<sup>3</sup> other than a Parking or Pedestrian Offense or the offense of Failure to Secure Child in Safety Seat System<sup>2</sup> that:  
(1) is committed outside a school crossing zone<sup>1</sup>; **and** (2) is a moving violation<sup>4</sup>
- H Appeal of a Class C Misdemeanor Rules-of-the-Road Offense<sup>3</sup> other than a Parking or Pedestrian Offense or the offense of Failure to Secure Child in Safety Seat System<sup>2</sup> that:  
(1) is committed outside a school crossing zone<sup>1</sup>; **and** (2) is not a moving violation<sup>4</sup>
- I Appeal of an offense under Education Code, §25.093 (Parent Contributing to Nonattendance) or Education Code, §25.094 (Failure to Attend School)
- J Appeal of a General Class C Misdemeanor<sup>5</sup> and the offense is a moving violation<sup>4</sup>
- K Appeal of a General Class C Misdemeanor<sup>5</sup> and the offense is not a moving violation<sup>4</sup>
