
**ORDER DECLARING ERIC FLORES A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT**

On this date, the Court considered *Defendant Texas Board of Disciplinary Appeals' Motion to Declare Plaintiff Eric Flores a Vexatious Litigant*. After a hearing on the motion, the Court **GRANTS** said motion.

**IT IS ORDERED**, that Eric Flores, Plaintiff in this cause, be designated a vexatious litigant pursuant to Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code Section 11.054.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED**, That Plaintiff Eric Flores provide security for the benefit of Defendant in the amount of \$ 5000, within 30 days of the signing of this Court's order pursuant to Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code Section 11.055, or this suit will be dismissed pursuant to Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code Section 11.056.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Clerk of Court shall, pursuant to Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code Section 11.104, provide the Office of Court Administration a copy of this Order Declaring Eric Flores a Vexatious Litigant and that Eric Flores shall be placed upon the state-wide list of vexatious litigants.
