**ORDER PROHIBITING PRO SE PLAINTIFF ROSA SERRANO FROM
FILING ANY NEW PRO SE LITIGATION WITHOUT PERMISSION OF LOCAL
ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE**

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT the Defendant Old Republic National Title Insurance Company's Motion to Declare Plaintiff a Vexatious Litigant and Request for Security came on for hearing before the Court. The Court granted Defendant's motion, declared *pro se* Plaintiff Rosa Serrano to be a vexatious litigant and required Plaintiff to furnish security in a separate order. Now, upon motion by Defendant Old Republic National Title Insurance Company, and also further upon the Court's own motion after hearing the evidence, enters this Pre-Filing Order prohibiting *pro se* Plaintiff Rosa Serrano, a vexatious litigant, from filing any new *pro se* litigation in any Court in the State of Texas without first receiving permission of the appropriate Local Administrative Judge, as required by Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem Code Ann. § 11.102(a).

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that *pro se* Plaintiff Rosa Serrano, a vexatious litigant, be, and is hereby **PROHIBITED** from filing any new *pro se*

litigation in any Court in the State of Texas without first obtaining permission of the appropriate Local Administrative Judge as described by Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem Code Ann. § 11.102(a).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that should *pro se* Plaintiff, Rosa Serrano, a vexatious litigant, file or commence any new *pro se* litigation in violation of this Order, that she shall be held in **CONTEMPT OF COURT**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that *pro se* Plaintiff, Rosa Serrano shall pay the security into the registry of the Court, by cash, money order, or other certified funds, on or before 5:00 p.m. local time, 15 days from the date this order is signed, and shall furnish to the Court and counsel for Defendant Old Republic National Title Insurance Company, an official deposit receipt from the El Paso County District Clerk's Office on or before 5:00 p.m. local time on the next day business day following the deposit.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that should *pro se* Plaintiff Rosa Serrano fail to timely deposit the security required by this order, that all of Plaintiff's claims against Defendant Old Republic National Title Insurance Company shall be DISMISSED in their entirety.
