


THE JUSTICES

Chief Justice Nathan L. Hecht was elected to the Court in 1988. He served as a Dallas County district court judge and as a justice on the Dallas Court of Appeals. He is a Yale University graduate and graduate of Southern Methodist University School of Law. He practiced law in Dallas.



Justice Paul W. Green was elected to the Court in 2004 after serving on the San Antonio Court of Appeals. He is a University of Texas at Austin graduate and earned his law degree from St. Mary's University. He practiced law in San Antonio.

Justice Phil Johnson was appointed to the Court in 2005 after serving as chief justice of the Amarillo Court of Appeals. He holds undergraduate and law degrees from Texas Tech University. He practiced law in Lubbock.



Justice Don R. Willett, appointed to the Court in 2005, served as deputy Texas attorney general, deputy U.S. assistant attorney general and special assistant to President George W. Bush. A Baylor University graduate, he earned law and master's degrees from Duke University and practiced law in Austin.

Justice Eva M. Guzman was appointed to the Court in 2009 after serving on the 14th Court of Appeals in Houston and as a Harris County district court judge. She is a graduate of the University of Houston and South Texas College of Law and practiced law in Houston.



Justice Debra H. Lehrmann was appointed to the Court in 2010 after serving as a Tarrant County trial court judge for more than 22 years. She is a graduate of the University of Texas at Austin and the UT School of Law. She practiced law in Fort Worth.

Justice Jeffrey S. Boyd was appointed to the Court in 2012 from his position as Gov. Rick Perry's chief of staff and, before that, served as the governor's general counsel. He is a graduate of Abilene Christian University and Pepperdine University School of Law. He practiced law in Austin.



Justice John P. Devine was elected to the Court in 2012. He previously served as a Harris County state district judge. He graduated from South Texas College of Law and from Ball State University in Indiana. He practiced law in Houston.

Justice Jeff Brown was appointed to the Court in 2013. He was a justice on Houston's 14th Court of Appeals and served as a Harris County district court judge. He is a graduate of the University of Texas at Austin and of the University of Houston Law Center. He practiced law in Houston.
