

**Request for Comments on Proposed
Code of Conduct and Professional Responsibility**

The Judicial Branch Certification Commission (JBCC) requests comments on the following proposed Code of Ethics and Professional Responsibility for licensed court interpreters.

The adoption of a Code of Ethics for each profession regulated by the JBCC, including court interpreters, is required by Section 152.151(a)(3) of the Government Code. The Code of Ethics, for the most part, was taken from the Code of Ethics as it existed when the licensed court interpreter program was administered by the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation.

Comments must be submitted in writing by 5:00 p.m. on June 5, 2015 to the Judicial Branch Certification Commission, c/o Office of Court Administration, P.O.
