ORDER

On this date, the Court considered Attorney General's Amicus Curiae Advisory Recommending Dismissal Pursuant to Res Judicata, Collateral Estoppel, and Chapter 14 and Advisory Regarding Vexatious Litigant and Advisory Regarding Pre-filing Order.

It is hereby **ORDERED** that Plaintiff's claims against Defendants are **DISMISSED AS FRIVOLOUS** for failure to comply with Chapter 14 of the Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code.

The Court finds Plaintiff Anthony Freeman is a vexatious litigant pursuant to section 11.054 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code. Plaintiff is hereby ordered to furnish security in the amount of \$ 350⁰⁰ by July 1, 2015 to proceed in this case. Failure to timely furnish security may result in dismissal of this suit.

Pursuant to section 11.101 of the Civil Practice and Remedies Code, the Court further orders that Plaintiff be prohibited from filing new litigation in any court in this State without permission from a local administrative judge in each new litigation. The clerk of the court shall forward a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration pursuant to section 11.104 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.

The court denies all relief not expressly granted in this judgment. This order disposes of all claims and all parties to this suit and will operate as a **FINAL JUDGMENT**.
