ORDER

On January 3, 2008, the Court considered 1) *Defendant's Motion to Designate Vexatious Litigants* and 2) *Defendant's Motion to Show Authority*. The Court, having considered the Motion, finds that the relief requested therein should be granted. It is therefore:

ORDERED that Gary Poenisch *has shown proper authority to represent* is ~~prohibited from filing any further pleadings or appearances in the above case.~~ *Barbara Schulze*

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT Barbara Schulze is declared by the Court to be a vexatious Litigant under Section 11.054 of The Texas Civil Practices & Remedies Code. *She shall provide security in the amount of 100,000.00 before proceeding with any further*

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT *she or any of her subjects* the following persons are prohibited from filing a *litigant in the month* new litigation in any Court in the State of Texas without first obtaining an order from the local administrative judge permitting the filing:

In addition, the above persons are ~~prohibited from filing any lawsuits against anyone for 240 days from the date of this order relating to the property at 407 Happy Trail San Antonio, Texas and the note and deed of trust relating to same.~~
