ORDER

Now before the court is the motion of defendants SunTrust Mortgage, Inc. and Michael J. McKleroy, Jr. (**movants**) to determine plaintiff Natasha Ann Ramsey to be a vexatious litigant. Upon consideration of movants' motion, the evidence presented and the arguments of counsel, the court hereby GRANTS movants' motion.

IT IS ORDERED the court declares Natasha Ann Ramsey is a vexatious litigant pursuant to section 11.054(1) of the Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the court declares Natasha Ann Ramsey is a vexatious litigant pursuant to section 11.054(2) of the Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the court finds that Ramsey was duly served with the motion and notice of this hearing and failed to file a response;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Natasha Ann Ramsey must provide security by obtaining a bond in the amount of \$ 24,106.51 + \$534 no later than 30 days for the benefit of movants to assure payment of their reasonable expenses in this suit;


