## ORDER OF THE SUPREME COURT OF TEXAS

## IN THE MATTER OF LAUREN ELIZABETH BUS SHERIDAN

The Court has considered the written tender of resignation submitted by Lauren Elizabeth Bus Sheridan, bar card number 24038725, and the Affidavit of Voluntary Resignation as Attorney and Counselor at Law affirming that the purpose of the voluntary resignation is not to avoid disciplinary action and the affiant has no knowledge of any unresolved allegation of professional misconduct against affiant. The Court has further considered the Certification of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel of the State Bar of Texas that there are no disciplinary actions pending against Lauren Elizabeth Bus Sheridan and that Lauren Elizabeth Bus Sheridan is not the subject of an investigation for professional misconduct. The Court concludes that the requirements of Article III, Section 6 of the State Bar Rules have been met in this matter.

Consequently, the Court determines that Lauren Elizabeth Bus Sheridan's license to practice law in the State of Texas and bar card number should be canceled and that Lauren Elizabeth Bus Sheridan should be removed from the list of persons licensed to practice law in the State of Texas.
