ORDER OF THE SUPREME COURT OF TEXAS

MISC. DOCKET NO. 14-9019

IN THE MATTER OF JANIS W. MYER

The Court has considered the written tender of resignation submitted by Janis W. Myer, bar card number 14756480, and the Affidavit of Voluntary Resignation as Attorney and Counselor at Law affirming that the purpose of the voluntary resignation is not to avoid disciplinary action and the affiant has no knowledge of any unresolved allegation of professional misconduct against affiant. The Court has further considered the Certification of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel of the State Bar of Texas that there are no disciplinary actions pending against Janis W. Myer and that Janis W. Myer is not the subject of an investigation for professional misconduct. The Court concludes that the requirements of Article III, Section 6 of the State Bar Rules have been met in this matter.

Consequently, the Court determines that Janis W. Myer's license to practice law in the State of Texas and bar card number should be canceled and that Janis W. Myer should be removed from the list of persons licensed to practice law in the State of Texas.
