IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Court that the aforementioned amendments to

the Standards be adopted and that the Standards for Certification in Family Law be amended so

as to hereafter read as follows:

I. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS AND DEFINITIONS

G. Family Law is the practice of law dealing with, by way of definition not limitation, matters involving the Texas Family Code, Titles 1, 2, and 4, and 5; Texas Penal Code, Chapter 25 (offenses against the family); the law of homestead and other exempt property; the taxation law of divorce and interspousal transaction; torts against the family; and the trial of cases arising out of the above matters; and the perfection of appeals from both interlocutory and final judgments. For the specific requirements in this area please refer to Section II(B).
