On the other hand, if I am not able to resign from the Bar as easily as I did, you should have told me.

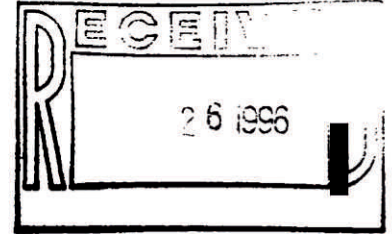
