**O P I N I O N**

This is an appeal from a judgment signed July 26, 1999. No clerk's record was filed. The clerk responsible for preparing the record in this appeal informed this court that appellant did not make arrangements to pay for the record. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 35.3(a)(2).
