## **Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument**

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in one appeal on Wednesday, June 6, 2012, beginning at 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Chief Justice Catherine Stone, Justice Phylis Speedlin, and Justice Steven C. Hilbig.

The following case will be presented:

Wael Anis Naime v. Nermien Sayad Soliman - The issues arising from the underlying divorce action concern the trial court's granting of the appellee's special appearance, including the authentication and translation of foreign documents admitted during the special appearance hearing. The appellant additionally argues that the trial court erred in failing to file requested findings of fact and conclusions of law.

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in one appeal on Thursday, June 7, 2012, beginning at 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Justice Sandee Bryan Marion, Justice Rebecca Simmons, and Justice Marialyn Barnard.

The following case will be presented:

Bexar County Appraisal District v. Soloman Abdo, A.L. Hernden, Frederick Zlotucha, Itamic, Inc., and George J. Abdo - This is an appeal from a jury verdict in favor of appellees. The underlying lawsuit involved an appeal by appellees from the Bexar County Appraisal Review Board's determination on the appraised value of three separate real property tracts owned by appellees. After the jury returned a verdict in favor of appellees, the Bexar Appraisal District filed this appeal, asserting the trial court erred in (1) awarding attorney's fees, (2) excluding a non-retained expert, and (3) charging the jury.

The oral arguments will be held in the Fourth Court's Courtroom, Cadena-Reeves Justice Center, Third Floor, 300 Dolorosa, San Antonio, Texas.
