Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in one appeal on Wednesday, July 9, 2014, beginning at 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Chief Justice Catherine Stone, Justice Marialyn Barnard, and Justice Luz Elena D. Chapa.

The following case will be presented:

Raymond Clark v. State of Texas - Raymond Clark appeals from his conviction for aggravated robbery. He raises three issues: (1) Whether a rational jury could conclude that he committed aggravated robbery; (2) Whether the trial court reversibly erred by not instructing the jury that it must unanimously agree on which elements of his affirmative defense of self-defense it rejected; and (3) Whether the trial court reversibly erred by instructing the jury on provocation as a limitation of his affirmative defense of self-defense.

The oral arguments will be held in the Fourth Court's Courtroom, Cadena-Reeves Justice Center, Third Floor, 300 Dolorosa, San Antonio, Texas.
