Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in one appeal on Wednesday, October 10, 2012, beginning at 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Chief Justice Catherine Stone, Justice Karen Angelini, and Justice Marialyn Barnard.

The following cases will be presented:

Hanford-Southport LLC v. City of San Antonio, Acting By and Through the San Antonio Water System – This appeal arises out of a statutory condemnation. In this appeal, the appellant does not contest the condemnation, but challenges the amount of the condemnation award.

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in one appeal on Wednesday, October 10, 2012, beginning at 10:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Justice Phylis Speedlin, Justice Rebecca Simmons, and Justice Steven C. Hilbig.

Kidwell, Dale Johnson, Larry Maddux, Individually and The City of Junction, Texas and The Junction Texas Economic Development Corporation - This appeal concerns whether the summary judgments filed by the defendants/appellees were properly granted as to the plaintiffs'/appellants' claims for violations of the Texas Open Meetings Act. Also at issue is whether attorney's fees were properly awarded under the Declaratory Judgments Act.
