

After hearing the arguments and evidence of counsel, it is the opinion of this Court that Defendants' Motion to Dismiss and Motion to Declare Plaintiff a Vexatious Litigant is with merit and should therefore be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, Defendants' Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED, said cause of action is hereby DISMISSED with prejudice; that is be removed from the docket of the Court; and that all costs incurred shall be taxed against Plaintiff.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants' Motion to Declare Plaintiff a Vexatious Litigant is GRANTED and Plaintiff is declared a Vexatious Litigant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Plaintiff must not file in propria persona any new litigation in a court in Texas against Defendants and their agents, directors, officers, employees, heirs or assigns without first obtaining permission from a local administrative judge as required by Texas Civil Practices & Remedies Code section 11.102.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED as required by Texas Civil Practices & Remedies Code section 11.104, the court clerk shall provide a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System.
