**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR ORDER DETERMINING PLAINTIFF TO BE A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT**

The court, having considered Defendant Geary & Spencer, P.C.'s ("Geary & Spencer") Motion for Order Determining Plaintiff to Be a Vexatious Litigant, the evidence presented at the hearing, the pleadings and other documents on file in this case, and the arguments of counsel, is of the opinion that plaintiff Frank McIntyre is a "vexatious litigant" as that term is defined in Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.054, and that the relief requested in the motion should be GRANTED.

~~IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that plaintiff Frank McIntyre post security with the district clerk in the form of a cash deposit or surety bond in the amount of \_\_\_\_\_ no later than \_\_\_\_\_ for the purpose of assuring payment of Geary & Spencer's reasonable expenses incurred in connection with the continuance of this case or an appeal. Provided, however, that Geary & Spencer shall not be entitled to payment of its reasonable expenses from the security if plaintiff succeeds in reversing the summary judgment in favor of Geary & Spencer on appeal.~~

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff Frank McIntyre is prohibited from filing new litigation in any Texas state or federal court against defendant ~~Geary & Spencer, P.C., Cleve Clinton, John Palter, Steve Sliman, SLS Consulting, Inc., John Sjovall, Charles M. Wilson, III, Craig Fowler,~~ <sup>BR</sup> and their agents, directors, officers, employees, heirs, assigns, representatives, insurers, adjusters, and attorneys, unless the local administrative judge of the court in which plaintiff intends to file the litigation first grants permission for him to do so under Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.102.
