Record

The record of testimony was duly reported by Tammy Goolsby, substituting for the official court reporter of the 307th Judicial District Court.

Findings

The Court finds that it is unlikely that Rebecca Alexander will prevail on matters before this Court and that she is a vexatious litigant pursuant to Section 11.054(2) of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code. The Court finds that Rebecca Alexander, in propria persona, has

attempted to relitigate issues which have been concluded by a final determination by this Court or a jury of this Court against Rebecca Alexander.

Orders

ONE THOUSAND FIVE NUMBERS

and 00/100 DOLLARS (\$1,500.00) into the Registry of this Court prior to requesting a setting on any of the motions pending before this Court which have been filed by Rebecca Alexander in this matter, except for the Motion for Enforcement Holding Michael Chad Horton in Contempt for Multiple Violations of May 28, 2010 Order and for Commitment to County Jail and Emergency Modification for Full Custody of Madison Paige Horton filed by Rebecca Alexander on February 15, 2011, which this Court shall hear on May 19, 2011, at 1:15 p.m. IT IS ORDERED that said security is an undertaking by Rebecca Alexander to assure payment to Michael Chad Horton and Raymond E. "Bo" Rogers, Jr. of their reasonable expenses, including costs and attorney's fees, incurred in or in conjunction with the underlying litigation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Rebecca Alexander is prohibited from filing a new litigation in a court of this state unless she has deposited the security ordered above in the Registry of this Court and the local administrative judge of Gregg County has granted permission to Rebecca Alexander to file the litigation.

In considering whether to grant permission to file new litigation, the local administrative judge shall grant permission for Rebecca Alexander to file litigation only if it appears to the judge that the litigation has merit and has not been filed for the purposes of harassment or delay.

The local administrative judge may condition permission for filing litigation on the furnishing of



additional security for the benefit of Michael Chad Horton as provided in Subchapter B of the Chapter 11 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that neither the District Clerk of Gregg County nor any clerk of this state shall file any litigation presented by Rebecca Alexander unless the filing of same has been preapproved and permitted by order of the local administrative judge. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the District Clerk of Gregg County shall provide to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System a copy of this order.
