ORDER DECLARING PLAINTIFF A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT

On October 27, 2006, the Court heard Defendants Ron McLaurin, Jesse Mendez, and Vilsen Salinas' motion requesting that Plaintiff Tommy Parker be found, and declared to be, a vexatious litigant, as defined by Section 11 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.

Appearances

Jesse Mendez appeared for the Defendants as counsel of record and as a Defendant proper.

Tommy Parker, a non-attorney Plaintiff, appeared pro se.

Record

A record of the proceedings was made by the official court reporter, Ms. Susan Myatt.

Hearing

The parties offered evidence in the form of oral testimony and exhibits, and they also presented arguments.

Findings of the Court

After considering the evidence and arguments of the parties, the Court finds that Defendants' motion should be, and hereby is, Granted. Accordingly, The Court finds that Tommy Parker is a vexatious litigant as defined by Section 11 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code, and the Court so declares Tommy Parker to be a vexatious litigant.

Orders of the Court

IT IS ORDERED that Tommy Parker is prohibited from filing in propria persona a new litigation in a court in the state of Texas unless the local Administrative Judge of the court in which Mr. Parker intends to file the litigation has granted permission to Mr. Parker under Section 11.102 of the Civil Practice and Remedies Code to file the said new litigation.

ULFICE OF COURT ADMINISTRATION The Court further ORDERS that the clerk of the Court provide to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System a copy of this Court's Order declaring Tommy Parker a vexatious litigant and prohibiting him from filing in *propria persona* new litigation unless approval has been given by the local Administrative Judge.

The Court Orders that all costs of court are taxed to Plaintiff Tommy Parker.
