


**ORDER OF THE SUPREME COURT
Of TEXAS**


IT IS ORDERED by the Supreme Court of Texas that the following amendment to Rule VI (C), Fees, of the *Standards and Rules for Certification of Certified Shorthand Reporters* are adopted and promulgated in conformity with Chapter 52 of the Texas Government Code as follows:


- (C) **Renewal Fee.** A fee of two hundred (\$200) dollars, shall be paid on or before the expiration date of the certification. Unless this fee is timely paid or the certification reinstated as provided in Rule 1.E., the certification previously issued shall expire at the date of the second anniversary of the date of the issuance of the certification.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Supreme Court approves the fee increase and this amended Rule VI (C) becomes effective September 1, 2001.


