

RULE 5. REPORTER'S RECORD

Each volume of the reporter's record shall comply with the requisites established by the Texas Rules of Appellate Procedure, the Local Rules for the Second Court of Appeals, and the Uniform Format Manual for Texas Court Reporters. In addition, except by permission of this court for good cause shown, the printed record filed with this court shall contain the record on computer diskette, CD, or DVD form in ASCII format or other computer readable format preapproved by this court. Said diskette, CD, or DVD shall be affixed to the inside of the back cover of the final volume of the printed reporter's record of testimony in such manner as to be secure but easily removable for use.




Approve Amendment to Local Rules


