ORDER APPOINTING ANCILLARY PROCEEDINGS TASK FORCE


Part VI of the Rules of Civil Procedure contains the rules governing attachment, distress warrants, execution, garnishment, injunctions, sequestration, and other ancillary proceedings. The language used in many of these rules is becoming outdated and may need clarification or revision to avoid conflicts with other rules of civil procedure, such as Rule 103.






Professor Elaine Carlson is appointed Chair. The Task Force is requested to submit a report and recommendations to the Court no later than October 31, 2008.






