


AMENDMENTS TO ORDER CREATING TEXAS ACCESS TO JUSTICE COMMISSION


ORDERED that the Order Establishing Texas Access to Justice Commission, Misc. Docket No. 01-9065 (April 26, 2001), is amended as follows:

1. The provision in paragraph 4 that the Court will appoint “a judge or justice from a county with a population of 650,000 or more” is revised to state that the Court will appoint “a judge or justice whose background and experience evidence an appreciation of issues regarding access to justice in larger counties”.
2. The provision in paragraph 4 that the Court will appoint “a judge or justice from a county with a population of less than 650,000” is revised to state that the Court will appoint “a judge or justice whose background and experience evidence an appreciation of issues regarding access to justice in smaller counties”.


