Dear Justice Gammage:

As you know, we transferred 350 cases from this Court to four other courts of appeals, in order to equalize the dockets. One case, styled *Grant v. State*, our docket cause no. 05-92-00930-CR, was transferred to the Court of Appeals, Thirteenth District of Texas at Corpus Christi. That Court assigned it cause no. 13-92-00326-CR.

After that transfer, it has come to our attention that a companion case, in which the same defendant was tried for another offense at the same time, has been filed in this Court. It is also styled *Grant v. State*; we have assigned it our cause no. 05-92-01585-CR, while the Corpus Christi Court has also assigned it a cause number, no. 13-92-00429-CR.

In the interest of judicial economy, the two appeals should be considered together. Consequently, we request an order transferring our cause no. 05-92-01585-CR, styled *Grant v. State*, to the Court of Appeals, Thirteenth District of Texas at Corpus Christi. We would appreciate your assistance in this matter.
