On February 28, 1992, the Supreme Court of Texas entered Miscellaneous Docket Order No. 92-0055, concerning the transfer of 75 cases from the First Court of Appeals to this Court. The following two cases were included in the 75 cases transferred from the First Court of Appeals:

13-92-130-CR Weathers, Ronald Earl  
v. Texas, The State of

13-92-203-CR Curry, Kevin Earl  
v. Texas, The State of

The Court traveled to Houston on February 18, 1993, to hear the remainder of the cases transferred to this Court from the Houston courts. The above-listed cases were set for submission on February 18, 1993; however, the appellate briefs in these cases had not been filed by the date of submission, and these two cases were removed from the submission docket. The appellant's brief in 13-92-203-CR has now been received, and appellant has requested oral argument. In 13-92-130-CR, the appellant has filed a motion requesting to supplement the record with the complete statement of facts and for an extension of time to file the brief.

Considering the additional time necessary to get these cases ready for submission and the additional expense which would be incurred by the State for this Court to travel to Houston to hear these cases, we respectfully request that these two cases be transferred back to the First Court of Appeals.
