
The Supreme Court of Texas hereby appoints the Honorable Philip O. Vick, Judge of the 158th District Court, to preside in the Disciplinary Action styled:

The Commission for Lawyer Discipline v. George A. Gonzalez


to be filed in a District Court of Bexar County, Texas.






