VOLUNTARY RESIGNATION OF ATTORNEYS


ORDER

My purpose of resigning is not to avoid disciplinary action, and I have no knowledge of any unresolved allegations of professional misconduct.

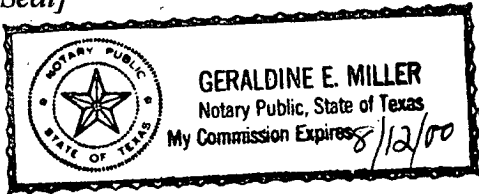
