

# COURTS OF APPEALS

## Analysis of Activity for the Year Ending August 31, 1984

There are 14 Courts of Appeals in Texas which, since September 1, 1981, have heard intermediate appeals in both civil and criminal cases.

Courts of Appeals are located in Fort Worth, Austin, San Antonio, Dallas, Texarkana, Amarillo, El Paso, Beaumont, Waco, Eastland, Tyler, Corpus Christi, and Houston. Houston has two Courts of Appeals. Each court has jurisdiction over a supreme judicial district.

Five of the courts have three justices each. The Dallas Court, with 13 justices, is the largest. There are 80 justices statewide.

### Criminal and Civil Backlogs Reduced

The 14 Courts of Appeals reduced both their civil and criminal pending caseloads during state fiscal year 1984 which ended August 31, 1984. The Courts disposed of 8,274 total cases during the year, an average of 103 dispositions (59 criminal and 44 civil) per justice.

It was the first time since calendar year 1973 that the Courts of Appeals ended a reporting year with fewer civil cases on their dockets than when the year began, and the second consecutive year that they reduced their criminal backlog.

The Courts of Appeals had 3,962 criminal cases and 2,643 civil cases pending as of September 1, 1983. On August 31, 1984, 3,500 criminal cases and 2,217 civil cases were pending. The total backlog of 5,717 pending cases was 13.4% less than the 6,605 case backlog at the beginning of the fiscal year. The state average for pending cases was 71.5 per justice.

A total of 6,951 cases were filed in the Courts of Appeals during the fiscal year, which included 3,988 criminal cases and 2,963 civil cases. This was a decrease of 4 percent from the 7,238 total cases filed in fiscal year 1983. Criminal cases added decreased 5 percent from the 4,202 filed in fiscal year 1983 and civil cases decreased 2 percent from the 3,036 filed in fiscal year 1983.

Year Ending August 31, 1984




#### Filings Averaged 86.9 Per Justice

Considering civil and criminal cases together, the Fifth Court in Dallas had the highest average number of new cases filed per justice (109.5) during fiscal year 1984. The other courts ranged down to 51.3 cases per justice filed in the Sixth Court in Texarkana. State average filings were 86.9 per justice.

The First Court of Appeals in Houston disposed of the largest number of cases per justice (131.2) during fiscal year 1983. State average dispositions were 103.4 per justice.

The largest number of pending cases per justice (97.3) at the end of the fiscal year was in the Twelfth Court of Appeals in Tyler. The lowest number per justice (48) was in the Tenth Court in Waco. The State average for pending cases was 71.5 per justice.

Approximately 24 percent of all cases filed in a Court of Appeals in Texas in fiscal year 1984 were filed in one of the two Courts located in Houston. Approximately 20 percent of all cases filed in the State were filed in the Dallas

#### Court.

In fiscal year 1984, the Courts of Appeals wrote 7,841 opinions, 3.0 percent more than the 7,613 written in calendar year 1983.

The Courts of Appeals reversed, at least in part, the decision of the trial court in 14 percent of the cases disposed of during fiscal year 1984, compared to 12.5 percent in calendar year 1983.

While the 14 Courts of Appeals operate to a large extent as autonomous courts in specific geographic areas, some equalization of the dockets occurs by transfer of cases among the courts by order of the Supreme Court, pursuant to Article 1738, V.T.C.S. The Supreme Court transferred 151 civil cases and 419 criminal cases in fiscal year 1984, compared with 130 civil cases and 552 criminal cases transferred in fiscal year 1983.

#### Disposition of Criminal Cases

Of the 3,500 criminal cases pending in the Courts of Appeals at the end of fiscal year 1984, 54 percent had been on the docket less than 6

months, 30 percent from 6 to 12 months, and 16 percent more than 12 months.

The average lapse of time between the filing of a criminal case in a Court of Appeals and its disposition ranged from 6.4 months in the Fort Worth Court to 14.3 months in the Tyler Court. The average lapse of time for cases statewide was 10.1 months.

A case is "submitted" when the court hears oral argument or when it is referred to the justices for formal consideration if no oral


argument is heard. The average lapse of time between submission of a criminal appeal and its disposition ranged from 0.5 of a month in the Beaumont Court to 2.9 months in the San Antonio and Corpus Christi Courts. The average lapse of time for cases statewide was 1.5 months.

#### New Civil Filings Decrease 3 Percent

New civil cases filed in all of the Courts of Appeals during fiscal year 1984 decreased 3

percent from fiscal year 1983. Fewer new civil cases were filed in fiscal year 1984 than in fiscal year 1983 in all but the Fort Worth, Austin Amarillo, Eastland, Tyler and Corpus Christi Courts. Of the courts with increased civil filings, the Eleventh Court in Eastland experienced the largest percentage increase--26 percent (18 cases). The Dallas Court continued to receive more new civil filings than any other court--545 compared to the average of 211.6 per court. The two courts in Houston, each of which has jurisdiction of the same geographical area, received a total of 648 civil cases, 56 cases (8 percent) less than in fiscal year 1983.

#### Pending Civil Caseload Declines

At the end of fiscal year 1984, 2,217 civil

cases were pending on the dockets of the Courts of Appeals, 18 percent less than the 2,715 pending on August 31, 1983. Of those civil cases pending on August 31, 1984, 53 percent had been on the docket less than 6 months, 29 percent from 6 to 12 months, and 18 percent for more than 12 months.


The average lapse of time between the filing of a civil case in a Court of Appeals and its disposition ranged from 5.0 months in the Waco and Eastland Courts to 13.6 months in the Amarillo Court. The average lapse of time for cases statewide was 9.1 months.

The average lapse of time from the submission of a civil case to the court and its disposition ranged from 0.7 of a month in the Waco and Eastland Courts to 4.0 months in the San Antonio Court. The average lapse of time for cases statewide was 2.3 months.
