ANALYSIS OF ACTIVITY FOR YEAR ENDED AUGUST 31, 1994

There are 14 Courts of Appeals in Texas which, since September 1, 1981, have heard intermediate appeals in civil and criminal cases.

Courts of Appeals are located in Fort Worth, Austin, San Antonio, Dallas, Texarkana, Amarillo, El Paso, Beaumont, Waco, Eastland, Tyler, Corpus Christi, and Houston. Houston has two Courts of Appeals. Each court has jurisdiction over a geographical district. The districts of the Houston courts are coterminous.

The number of justices for each court ranges from 3 each in five courts to 13 in Dallas, which is the largest. There are 80 justices statewide.

PENDING CASELOADS INCREASED AGAIN


For the seventh consecutive year, total pending caseloads of the 14 Courts of Appeals increased

during the state fiscal year which ended August 31, 1994.


The pending caseload increased from 9,080 at the beginning of the fiscal year 1994 to 9,127 at the end of the fiscal year.

The Courts of Appeals had 6,386 criminal cases and 2,694 civil cases pending as of September 1, 1993. On August 31, 1994, 6,140 criminal cases and 2,987 civil cases were pending. The state average for pending cases at year's end was 114 per justice.

Of the 6,140 criminal cases pending in the Courts of Appeals at the end of fiscal year 1994, 40.4 percent had been on the docket less than 6 months, 26.3 percent from 6 to 12 months, and 33.3 percent more than 12 months.

At the end of fiscal year 1994, 2,987 civil cases were pending on the dockets of the Courts of Appeals, 10.9 percent more than the 2,694 pending on September 1, 1993. Of those civil cases pending on August 31, 1994, 49 percent had been on the docket less than 6 months, 30 percent from 6 to 12 months, and 21 percent for more than 12 months.

The largest number of pending cases per justice (180) at the end of the fiscal year was in the Fifth Court of Appeals in Dallas. The lowest number per justice (70) was in the Seventh Court of Appeals in Amarillo.

NEW CASE FILINGS

A total of 9,297 new cases was filed in the Courts of Appeals during the fiscal year, which included 5,071 criminal cases and 4,226 civil cases. This was a decrease of 1.3 percent from the 9,420 total new cases filed in fiscal year 1993. New criminal cases decreased 5.5 percent from the 5,364 filed in fiscal year 1993 and civil cases increased 4.2 percent from the 4,056 filed in fiscal year 1993.

Considering civil and criminal cases together, the Fifth Court of Appeals in Dallas had the highest average number of new cases filed per justice (154) during fiscal year 1994. The other courts ranged down to 51 cases per justice filed in the Eleventh Court of Appeals in Eastland. State average filings were 120 per justice.

Approximately 27 percent of all new cases filed in a Court of Appeals in Texas in fiscal year 1994 were

filed in the two courts located in Houston. Approximately 21.5 percent of all new cases filed in the State were filed in the Fifth Court of Appeals in Dallas.

DISPOSITIONS

The courts disposed of 9,543 total cases during the year, an average of 119 dispositions (68 criminal and 51 civil) per justice.

The Fifth Court of Appeals in Dallas disposed of the largest total number of cases per justice (145) during fiscal year 1994. The lowest number per justice (94) was in the Tenth Court of Appeals in Waco. State average dispositions were 119 per justice.

CRIMINAL DISPOSITIONS

Criminal dispositions increased 7.9 percent from 5,057 dispositions in fiscal year 1993 to 5,456 dispositions in fiscal year 1994.

The average lapse of time between the filing of a criminal case in a Court of Appeals and its disposition ranged from 6.5 months in the Sixth Court of Appeals in Texarkana to 17.9 months in the Fifth Court of Appeals in Dallas. The average lapse of time for the 14 courts was 11.5 months.

The average lapse of time between submission of a criminal appeal and its disposition ranged from 0.7 of a month in the Sixth Court of Appeals in Texarkana, Seventh Court of Appeals in Amarillo, and Fourteenth Court of Appeals in Houston to 4.8 months

in the Thirteenth Court of Appeals in Corpus Christi. The average lapse of time for the 14 courts was 1.8 months.

CIVIL DISPOSITIONS

In fiscal year 1994, there were 4,087 civil dispositions by the Courts of Appeals, a decrease of 11.1 percent from the 4,597 civil dispositions in fiscal year 1993.

The average lapse of time between the filing of a civil case in a Court of Appeals and its disposition ranged from 4.5 months in the Sixth Court of Appeals in Texarkana to 10.0 months in the Thirteenth Court of Appeals in Corpus Christi. The average lapse of time in the 14 courts for civil cases was 8.3 months.

The average lapse of time from the submission to the court of a civil case and its disposition ranged from 0.9 month in the Sixth Court of Appeals in Texarkana to 6.5 months in the Thirteenth Court of Appeals in Corpus Christi. The average lapse of time for the 14 courts was 2.6 months. A case is "submitted" when the court hears oral argument or when it is referred to the justices for formal consideration if no oral argument is heard.

OPINIONS WRITTEN

In fiscal year 1994, the justices of the Courts of Appeals wrote 9,301 opinions, 1.0 percent less than the 9,379 written in 1993.


The Courts of Appeals reversed, at least in part, the decision of the trial court in 12.0 percent of the cases disposed of during fiscal year 1994, a 1.0 percent decrease from fiscal year 1993.

CASES TRANSFERRED

While the 14 Courts of Appeals operate to a large extent as autonomous courts in specific geographic districts, some equalization of the dockets occurs by transfer of cases among the courts on order of the Supreme Court, pursuant to statutory authority. The Supreme Court transferred a total of 271 civil cases and 649 criminal cases among the courts in fiscal year 1994, compared with 119 civil cases and 268 criminal cases transferred in fiscal year 1993. In addition, the two Houston Courts (1st and 14th) are authorized by statute to transfer cases between those courts. During 1994, the 1st Court transferred one civil and one criminal case to the 14th. The 14th transferred three civil cases and one criminal case to the 1st Court.
