## ORDER OF SUSPENSION

Hon. David B. Lewis


Pursuant to Article 5, Section 1-a(6)A of the Texas Constitution, and Rule 15(b) of the Texas Procedural Rules for the Removal or Retirement of Judges, the State Commission on Judicial Conduct has recommended the immediate suspension, without pay, of the Honorable David B. Lewis, Justice on the Fifth Court of Appeals, Dallas County, Texas, for a period of no less than six (6) months from the date of this Order. In the Agreed Motion for Order of Suspension, Justice Lewis and the Commission have agreed that: no Findings of Fact or Conclusions of Law have been made by the Commission in connection with this action; Justice Lewis does not admit guilt, fault, or wrongdoing regarding the allegations contained in the Sworn Complaint; Justice Lewis agrees to a temporary suspension from office, without pay; and the suspension shall remain in effect until final disposition of the allegations made the basis of this inquiry and further orders of this Court.

Having considered the Agreed Motion for Order of Suspension, it is the Order of the Supreme Court of Texas that the Honorable David B. Lewis of the Fifth Court of Appeals, Dallas County, Texas, be immediately suspended from office, without pay, for a period of no less than six (6) months from the date of this Order, and the suspension shall remain in effect pending final disposition of the charge before the Commission and further orders of this Court.
