Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in two appeals on Tuesday, January 12, 2016, beginning at 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Chief Justice Sandee Bryan Marion, Justice Rebeca C. Martinez, and Justice Jason Pulliam.

The following cases will be presented:

Robert Alan Queeman v. The State of Texas - The sole issue presented in this appeal by appellant is whether the evidence is legally sufficient to support his conviction of criminally negligent homicide.

Erick Lopez v. Adam Huron d/b/a Adam's Mexican Food Products - Erick Lopez appeals a judgment entered against him based on a jury's findings that he breached implied warranties relating to plastic bags he sold to Adam Huron d/b/a Adam's Mexican Food Products. Lopez presents three issues on appeal asserting the trial court erred by: (1) entering judgment against him because no jury finding was requested or made regarding any statutory exception a claimant is required to prove to hold a nonmanufacturing seller liable for a products liability claim; (2) ordering him to pay attorney's fees if the trial court erred in entering judgment against him; and (3) ordering him to pay Huron attorney's fees for the defense of Lopez's counterclaims.

The oral arguments will be held in the Fourth Court's Courtroom, Cadena-Reeves Justice Center, Third Floor, 300 Dolorosa, San Antonio, Texas.
