Transaction Volume


- 2016 State filing portal accounted for 75.81% of transactions and the remaining 24.19% stemmed from commercial EFSP submissions
- 2017 State filing portal accounted for 78.05% of transactions and the remaining 21.98% stemmed from commercial EFSP submissions

Summary


- Transaction volume increased 14%

Responses in Under 24 Hours




Summary




Summary

Self-represented litigants can now use efileTexasTM Self-help, a free online service available to create and file court forms. eFileTexas Self-help is an easy-to-use application to help self-represented litigants generate legal documents for certain types of case filings. Working much like popular tax preparation software, it guides users through a series of questions to automatically generate and file court forms. As a web-based tool, it offers self-represented litigants the flexibility of completing interviews anytime, from anywhere. It can also reduce the number of erroneous filings for the court and decrease staff time spent answering self-represented litigants' questions.

Details

Q1 Development Items

- Criminal Initiation Phase 2 to update the filer user interface to include all data elements supported by ECF APIs
- Enhanced Data Fields will add case sub-types and case cross reference numbers as available fields for filers/reviewers

Q2 Development Items

- Redaction (Filer / Review) to allow for filers and clerks to redact documents through eFileTexas
- HTML5 Review Tool to replace the Silverlight version that clerks currently use during review
- SelfHelp Platform Alignment functionality updates to enhance the solution, making it easier to utilize and more device agnostic (mobile friendly)

Q3 Development Items

- HTML5 Filer Tool to make the eFileTexas filing portal ECF5 compliant
- HTML5 Admin Screens to completely deprecate Silverlight
- Code Editor (Version 1) to develop better support tools for handling common configuration requests

Q4 Development Items

- Batch Filing UI to allow for users to file multiple filings across multiple cases at once, in batch
- eCitation Initiation via EFM to allow for electronic citations through the EFM (*Note: eCitation Initiation via user interface is currently scheduled to be development complete in Q1 of 2019)

*Note: Schedule denotes when items will be "development complete". Solution updates will need to be made before features are available to users. Schedule is tentative and subject to change.

Next Steps: Now through July





- 1. Continue the phased implementation rollout of criminal e-filing
- 2. Continue enriching the eFileTexas
 Self-Help program by adding
 additional interviews and enhancing
 community outreach
- 3. Continue implementing Justice Courts with standard eFiling codes
