Dear Mr. Legate:

At its August 15, 2015 meeting, the FSC voted to dismiss your complaint, because the examiner's conclusion in your case—"indeterminate"—was expressed in accordance with currently accepted gunshot residue analysis guidelines, and therefore the complaint failed to articulate a basis for conducting an investigation of professional negligence or misconduct.

The Scientific Working Group for Gunshot Residue Analysis'—the national working group for development of gunshot residue analysis guidelines—current guidelines provide that it is not possible to determine whether a subject has discharged a firearm in the absence of gunshot residue; thus use of the word "indeterminate" would be appropriate to express an examiner's conclusion regarding whether a particular suspect fired the weapon. <sup>1</sup>

Any additional or outstanding legal issues in your case should be discussed with your legal representative. A list of innocence clinics operating in the State of Texas is enclosed for your convenience.
