Dear Mr. Wilcox:

At its October 2, 2015 meeting, the FSC voted unanimously to dismiss your complaint for failure to state an allegation of professional negligence or misconduct relative to a forensic analysis against an accredited laboratory. However, the DNA testing in your case involves a mixture interpretation and may fall under our DNA mixture statewide case review. The purpose of this review is to ensure that proper DNA mixture protocols were utilized when interpreting test results in Texas criminal cases.

Bob Wicoff, Chief of the Appellate Division of the Harris County Public Defender's Office, is currently heading up the FSC's DNA mixture statewide case review. The FSC will forward your case to Mr. Wicoff for review to evaluate the DNA analysis.
