Dear Mr. Brown:

At its February 12, 2016 meeting, the FSC voted unanimously to dismiss your complaint. The original forensic analysis performed in your case occurred in 1997. The FSC is prohibited from conducting a negligence or misconduct review for cases pre-dating the Texas crime laboratory accreditation program. The Commission may review older cases for best practices and other recommendations that would benefit the forensic community but the FSC chose not to do so in this case.
