At its April 12, 2016 meeting, the Commission voted unanimously to dismiss your complaint for failure to state an allegation of negligence or misconduct related to the forensic analysis at issue in the case. Your complaint asserts general defenses to the prosecution for DWI not subject to review by the Commission. Moreover, the testing of blood sugar levels is not subject to review by the Commission.
