At its July 8, 2016 meeting, the Commission voted unanimously to dismiss your complaint for failure to state an allegation of negligence or misconduct related to the forensic toxicology analysis in your case. Your complaint asks the Commission to review the toxicology analysis for the sole purpose of determining whether the medical examiner's findings may have been inaccurate. The portion of an autopsy conducted by a medical examiner or other forensic pathologist is exempt from review by the Commission.
